Zulu Craft and Music

- 1 Make a piece of bead [jewellery](#).
- 2 The Zulu people use patterns and shapes in their [beadwork](#) with different meanings. Find out about these.
- 3 [Weaving](#) - another Zulu craft. Can you weave? Try making a bag, basket, box or table mat.
- 4 Use sweet wrappers to make patterns, pictures or a [collage](#). The foil and coloured cellophane from chocolates is ideal, e.g. Cadbury's Roses.
- 5 [Pottery](#) - can you make a small pot using salt dough, clay or similar and decorate it with Zulu designs?

Whose Rights?

- 1 **Peer group pressure** - what is it? Take part in an activity that develops your understanding of this.
- 2 **Equal rights**. Explore children's rights under the UN Convention and compare how these affect children worldwide.
- 3 **Gender equality** - find out why this is important.
- 4 Find out what one of these says about **Rights** - the EU, the UN or the UK Government.

Background: KwaZulu Natal is a region in the eastern part of South Africa where the Zulu people have been profoundly affected by HIV/AIDS and many adults have died. Maintaining traditional houses is difficult for the older generation of grandparents who care for the children and young people, therefore the houses fall into disrepair.
